RULES: Tay Tay Bass Tournament Rules

- 1. Fish Must be released after caught
- 2. 5 Fish max for weigh ins
- 3. Properly record and submit EVERY fish you would like to submit
- 4. Must Have Scale
- 5. No weights in fish
- 6. Must have a valid license (boating and fishing)
- 7. Fish only counts if Taylor does not suspect any cheating or suspicious behavior in the videos/submissions
- 8. ONLY BASS!
- 9. NO DRAMA! (If any DQ)
- 10. Must be signed in to participate
- 11. Must pay entry fee to participate
- 12. No intoxication or drugs (DQ if so)
- 13. If using a boat must have all safety equipment
- 14. Weigh-ins will close 30 min after the predicted time of 5:00 P.M.
- 15. If tie there is a 1 hour fishing period for team(s) first one to catch a bass over 1 lbs
- 16. Fish attractants are NOT LEGAL in the tournament
- 17. No fish submissions will be taken before 9:00 A.M. or after 5:00 P.M.

Video recording steps

- 18. Record Catch of fish
- Start video before you hookset fish(If possible)
- Show fish being landed no matter what
- Clearly show scale being calibrated starting at 0.0
- Weigh the fish then say fish weight outloud (Ex. Weight of fish is 1 lbs 2 oz)
- Show ID card provided at the beginning of the tournament
- Show your face at least once in the video
- Then fill out required information in google form
- Submit and repeat
- 19. At the end decide top 5 heaviest fish you caught to submit for weigh ins
